Travel to the RSC

Travel from Glasgow city centre

Bus

Buses take about 25 minutes and stop on Maryhill Road beside the West of Scotland Science Park.

First Group: every 10 minutes from Hope Street stop before Sauchiehall Street:

No. 40 Clydebank or No. 109/119 Baljaffray

First Group: every hour from Buchanan Street Station:

No. 8 or 10 Balfron

Train

Trains take 15 minutes followed by a 15 minute walk from the station to the RSC.

Scotrail: Trains from Queen Street Station to Maryhill Station every 30 minutes.

From Maryhill Station turn left onto Maryhill Road. Continue along Maryhill Rd until you reach the Science Park roundabout. Todd Campus is on the right hand side.

Bicycle

Taxi

Taxis to the RSC from Glasgow city centre take about 20 minutes.

Car

From East (M8 motorway westbound)

1. Exit at Junction 16 and follow the A81 for Aberfoyle. Continue on this road till you pass through Maryhill and the road turns to dual carriageway.
2. After about 500 yards you come to the West of Scotland Science Park roundabout. Turn right into Todd Campus.
3. Turn left at the mini roundabout. You will see 1 Todd Campus straight ahead. The car park is behind the building as you approach it.

From West (M8 motorway eastbound / Glasgow airport)

1. Exit at Junction 25 and follow signs for the Clyde Tunnel. Go through the Tunnel and continue on the A739, following signs for Aberfoyle.
2. Continue on this road, straight through the traffic lights at Anniesland Cross, and on to Canniesburn Toll roundabout.
3. Take the 3rd exit at the roundabout and follow signs for the A81 City Centre.
4. After about 500 yards dual carriageway you come to the West of Scotland Science Park roundabout. Turn left into Todd Campus.
5. Turn left again at the mini roundabout. You will see 1 Todd Campus straight ahead. The car park is behind the building as you approach it.

Long Distance Travel

Air

See the [Glasgow Airport](#) website for up-to-date travel information. The RSC is 5 miles north-east of the airport and the journey will take about 30 minutes by taxi. Alternatively, it will take over an hour to travel to the RSC by bus, first catching a bus from the airport to Glasgow city centre and then another bus out to the RSC (as detailed in the Bus travel section above).

Rail

Glasgow is served by two main stations which lie in the City Centre. Trains coming to Glasgow from the South (unless coming via Edinburgh) terminate at **Central Station** and trains from East and Northern Scotland terminate at **Queen Street Station**. Coach

Coaches to Glasgow terminate at **Buchanan Bus Station** in the city centre. See the [Strathclyde Partnership for Transport](#) website for further information.
